

Watering Can

NO WATERING CAN? NO PROBLEM! YOU CAN MAKE ONE OUT OF AN EMPTY MILK BOTTLE.

Start Here!

STEP 1



Use a needle or scissors to poke holes in the milk

STEP 2



Fill the bottle with water and twist the lid back on.

STEP 3



Squeeze your watering can to release a gentle flow of water.

You're all set to start growing a balcony allotment!

Did you know?

The Royal Parks grow up to 450,000 bedding plants and shrubs at a time. Fortunately we don't have to water them all by hand!



You will need:

- Empty Milk Bottle
- A Pin

The best time to water your balcony or window allotment is early morning or late evening. Make sure not to get water on the leaves, as the sunlight going through water droplets can damage the plant. Have a look at our other resources to see some easy plants for beginners to grow.
