Thank you for your request of 17th April 2026. I would like to apologise again for the delay in sending responses to you. We have reviewed your request and determined that it seeks "environmental information" as defined in regulation 2(1) of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004. Accordingly, we have handled it under the EIR rather than the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Royal Parks has provided answers in bold below:

Please will you send me the following information:

1. Copies of TRP documents, including Board meeting minutes since 1st January 2018, in which the needs of disabled people and/or those with limited mobility in developing and implementing the Movement Strategy were referred to.

Please find attached the following six documents in relation to our Movement Strategy. Please note that redactions have been made to these documents to withhold personal data from disclosure in accordance with regulation 13(1) of the EIR.
