

IMPORTANT NOTICE

CANNING GREEN is the lawn on the land bounded by Great George Street, Parliament Square, Broad Sanctuary and Little George Street.

Canning Green is managed by The Royal Parks and is currently closed to the public. No access to this area is allowed until further notice. Unauthorised access is trespass.

The Royal Parks and Other Open Spaces Regulations 1997 (as amended) apply in Canning Green. Under the Regulations no person may (among other things):

- without the permission of The Royal Parks attach any article to, climb or interfere with any tree, railing, fence, statue, seat, building or structure.
- fail to comply with a reasonable direction given by a constable to leave any part of Canning Green.
- without reasonable excuse fail to comply with a direction of a constable to cease or not start a “prohibited activity”. “Prohibited activities” are:
 - a. operating any amplified noise equipment;
 - b. erecting or keeping erected;
 - i. any tent, or
 - ii. any other structure that is designed, or adapted, (solely or mainly) for the purpose of facilitating sleeping or staying in a place for any period;
 - c. using any tent or other such structure for the purpose of sleeping or staying in that area;
 - d. placing or keeping in place any sleeping equipment with a view to its use (whether or not by the person placing it or keeping it in place) for the purpose of sleeping overnight in that area;
 - e. using any sleeping equipment for the purpose of sleeping overnight in that area.

Failure to comply with these or any other of the Regulations is a criminal offence under the Parks Regulation (Amendment) Act 1926.
